Qadisha Cave:

- Is the flip side of the nature in Bsharre and its region in terms of geographical, environmental and historical diversity
- Qadisha Cave was formed thousands of years ago, away from the public eye and from the
 affluence of the Qadisha River, from which it holds its name and which takes source in the
 cave.
- Qadisha Cave, which overlooks the Valley of the Saints and lies under The Cedars of God Forest, encloses geometric shapes made by the nature, and was formed over the years.
- It was discovered in 1925 by Father Mtanios Geagea and by Hanna Dala Geagea. It belongs to the Municipality of Bsharre.
- The beholder to this triangle, composed of The Cedars of God Forest, Qadisha Cave and Qadisha Valley the Valley of the Saints, which is geographically bound, cannot but be amazed by the nature's uniqueness and beauty.
