Future prospects:

A plan is being discussed to convey the environmental and religious sightseeing of the valley into the new reality through the study plan that is being discussed for the rehabilitation of religious heritage sites and monuments in the Valley:

- Rehabilitation of the dirt road from Saint Eliseus down to Our Lady of
 Qannoubine and paving it according to the specifications proposed by the World
 Heritage and in accordance with the UNESCO, and implementing a firefighting
 system to protect the site.
- Rehabilitation of religious sites to preserve them and protect them from demolition and damage, and rehabilitating a pedestrian road to form an integrated network linking the valley villages located on its banks. Then linking the main road to the pedestrian road.
- Regulate the movement of visitors and tourists into the valley through the
 establishment of reception centers and manage the site through the
 development of a unified transportation means. The proposed centers and
 means of transportation should be put in force by the Union of Municipalities.
- Revive the agricultural life in the valley in order to be consistent with the site's uniqueness and distinctiveness
- Supervise what is being implemented on the power supply network to ensure the proper execution and to keep up with the revitalization that is being put in force at all levels all over the Caza.
