In the heights of Mount al-Makmal, at an altitude of 3090 meters above sea level, the Black Peak together with its surroundings are considered the main reservoir that feeds freshwater springs in the Bsharre- Al Donnieh- Zgharta- Baalbek districts, as snow covers some places of this peak all year long. It's also the highest peak in the Middle East.

On this peak, one can find many wild plants that are rare and endangered.
